



# PRAYER LETTER

August 2010

## Day 1

Pray as an airline woman writes, *“I am now at a level of desperation in my life where so many things seem to be falling apart ... my marriage, my ability to walk, and, in general, any scrap of sanity I have left .... I do know enough to know I am in desperate need of prayer and need a few real miracles in my life (and the lives of others) to have any interest in continuing to ‘fight the good fight.’ I feel like a dying warrior now. There seems to be no way out. I know God CAN make a way where there seems none. I am just very, very tired of ‘fighting’ the ‘enemy’ and request your prayers that I may be strengthened to continue ‘fighting the good fight’ and trying to serve our Father in Heaven.”*

## Day 2

Pray for Horizon Airlines. Service cutbacks at the end of summer will result in 20 employees in Boise alone losing their jobs. (No report on how many at other locations.) Pray for all concerned, that needs will be met. Frontier Airlines is also discontinuing Boise service at year’s end, and this too will affect employment status.

## Day 3

**FCAP DAY OF PRAYER — Pray for revival in the hearts and lives of airline people worldwide!**

Give thanks for two contacts in Paris, France — Mark (a pilot) and Monica (a flight attendant). Pray as they have a heart for wanting to see a fellowship group established there among airline co-workers.

## Day 4

As James Oludipe makes contact with airline personnel in Nigeria to bring love and the Gospel message to them, pray for open and responsive hearts. Pray God will raise up airline co-workers in Nigeria who are willing to stand for the Lord and shine for His glory.

Pray for an airline believer undergoing family challenges. She has little time to minister to her difficult teenager. Pray

other Christians will come along side her to help and encourage her.

## Day 5

Give thanks for how God continues to use the Sassers and medical mission teams they lead into third world countries. His hand was evident once again in their recent trip to Kenya. Please continue to pray for future outreach:

Pray for space availability on all of their flights as seats are filling up. Also pray for special wisdom regarding the trip to Uganda scheduled August 13-30. There is some concern about that part of the world right now, and it looks like the medical team they are partnering with may postpone. But tickets for the team are non-refundable. Please pray the airline will have mercy and that all money for the tickets will come in to pay for them.

## Day 6

Give thanks for a new contact in Bogota, Colombia. His is a Colombian military pilot who desires to see Christians connect in the aviation-airline community in his country. Give thanks for the availability of a Spanish-speaking FCAPer to help translate for us in communication with this brother.

Continue to pray doors will open for ministry throughout Latin America.

## Day 7

At the FCAP International Office we are feeling the effects of a struggling economy, and meeting our financial obligations at present is a major challenge. At the same time, we see ministry opportunities increasing throughout the world. Please join us in crying out to the Lord for His continued provision for what is needed to carry on with His work for His glory in the airlines of the world. Pray for wisdom in making decisions, tough ones at times, in response to limited financial resources. (We are so hoping to have the funds soon to publish another TRIM TAB ... desire is certainly there, but the funds have not been.)

## Day 8

Pray for a buyer for Bill Sassers old dental office. They thought they had one, but now that is in question. Please pray they will go through with the contract. Pray as a young single mother needs to find a stable, part-time job.

## Day 9

Pray as CERG (Christian Employees Resource Group) within American Airlines will hold their National Conference in Miami at the Airport Hotel on September 14. Pray for positive response and that the end result will bring great glory to the Lord Jesus Christ. Pray new connections will be made at this meeting as Ana Duarte and Evelyn Beharry spend time there and set up a FCAP display.

As FCAP-related children return to school, pray for God’s hand of protection around them physically, emotionally, and spiritually.

## Day 10

**FCAP DAY OF PRAYER — Pray for revival in the hearts and lives of airline people worldwide!**

Pray as there is need for a new chaplain at the Baton Rouge Airport. Pray God will go before this new chaplain in establishing connections and good

relationships with the personnel there. Pray for a connection with airline believers who do not yet know of each other.

#### Day 11

Pray for God's continued protection and direction upon our FCAP web site ([www.fcap.org](http://www.fcap.org)). We are trying to utilize this means of outreach in every possible way to introduce the ministry, to present the Gospel, to encourage Christians, to direct people to the study of His Word, to provide instant access to all of our available publications, to let people know what events are coming up, to give an overview of events that have taken place ... and more. Pray God will equip us in every way to accomplish all of this for His glory and advancement of His kingdom throughout the airlines of the world.

#### Day 12

Our next FCAP Adventure on the Seas cruise is set to embark on October 25. Pray for positive response and receptive hearts to what God desires to accomplish in and through this time for His glory. Pray for God's provision in the lives of some who would like to participate but are currently unable to make plans to do so. Pray for a young man in his early 20's who is deep into debt. In addition to asking for the Lord's leading to wise solutions, pray he will draw closer to the Lord.

#### Day 13

Pray new contacts in Jamaica would unify to be an effective light source for bringing Christians together there and drawing others to Christ. Remember today our Christian brothers and sisters living and working in countries hostile toward the Gospel.

#### Day 14

With the reduction of financial gifts, especially over the summer months, we are temporarily postponing the TRIM TAB. However, we are providing a new monthly publication entitled *In the JetStream* that can be downloaded and printed from the FCAP website. We are planning to some other creative publications that can be accessed easily and are more current. Please pray for this new endeavor with our publications.

#### Day 15

Pray for space availability on flights and travel safety for those coming to be part of our August 17-18 Basic Training session at FCAP headquarters. Continue to pray for the sale of two homes, both belonging

to widows desiring or needing to downsize. For one, it is necessary for financial reasons to make this change as soon as a possible.

#### Day 16

Pray hearts will be open and responsive to all God desires to accomplish in and through these two upcoming days of Basic Training (August 17-18). Pray those leading the sessions will have discernment in meeting the needs of all in attendance. Pray logistics regarding lodging and meals will go smoothly as we make transitions in those two areas.

#### Day 21

Pray for airline people struggling with frustrating life issues. Pray they would learn to abide in Christ, trusting Him and not fostering a bitter heart. Pray they would be able to keep their eyes and hearts focused on Him rather than on the circumstances of life.

#### Day 22

For many years, Jerry Litwiller (Continental) hosted a breakfast fellowship in the Allentown, PA area. It proved to be a most encouraging time with very positive impact. Now that he has relocated to San Diego, Jerry is starting the same outreach there. Their inaugural breakfast fellowship was held on June 25 and resulted in a time of special blessing with 15 in attendance. Pray this would be the start of something new and exciting in reaching out to airline personnel in the San Diego and southern California area.

#### Day 23

Please uplift this family before God's throne of grace. The dad is a pilot. Pray for healing and restoration in all broken marriage and family relationships represented within our airline community.

### Day 27

In July, FCAP had opportunity to present portions of our Basic Training at a local church in the Atlanta area attended by a number of airline employees. Pray this will prove to be a catalyst for growing outreach among co-workers as they grab hold of the vision and seek God's leading in implementing the things they have learned. Pray additional churches in many cities will desire to make this and our Peacemaker Training available to their people.

As the airport fellowship grows, pray God will raise up more FCAP volunteers to help with these meetings. As the Southside Bible study held in Atlanta grows, pray God will give wisdom, peace, and direction to the leader and to those opening their homes for this study in McDonough.
